

Accessing NHS Dental Treatment in St Helens.

November 2023

Report produced by the Healthwatch St Helens Support Team



Background

The Healthwatch network across Cheshire & Merseyside has repeatedly raised concerns with NHS England about the lack of NHS dentists and the struggles that people are facing to find affordable dental treatment.

Over the last few years, there has been a massive increase in the number of enquiries we have received about dental treatment in St Helens. The people we have spoken to are struggling to find a dentist who can provide NHS treatment with some people considering taking out loans in order to pay for dental treatment. Many are suffering in pain, and some are facing serious health implications as a result of not being able to have the dental treatment they need.

There was a massive backlog of patients waiting to access NHS treatment nationally. This began with the COVID-19 pandemic which led to practices offering considerably less appointments each day due to the cleaning that was required between each patient being in the surgery. However, we also know that there are huge issues with how NHS dentists are funded.

What did we do?

- We highlighted this issue to local Councillors, who invited us to attend a 'Spotlight on Dentistry' held by the Health Scrutiny Committee.
- Along with colleagues from the Healthwatch network, attended a 'Dental Deep Dive' with the Cheshire & Mersey Integrated Care Board to look at this issue in more detail.
- Made regular contact with NHS England to highlight cases that came in to us. This is ongoing and we will continue to raise concerns.
- We contacted all dental practices in the borough to find out what the situation was with each practice, whether there are taking on new patients and whether they have a waiting list. We also highlight which practices are dementia friendly. You can find the list at the end of this report.

What difference have we made?

- Local Councillors have committed to putting pressure on NHS England to increase funding for NHS Dentists.
- The Cheshire & Mersey Integrated Care Board has committed to agreeing and implementing a Dental Recovery Plan since dentistry became part of their remit on 1st April, 2023.
- By regularly revising our booklet about accessing NHS dental treatment, local people have the most up-to-date useful information and contacts.

What you should do if you need dental treatment.

For emergency dental treatment you should call the emergency dental helpline on: 0161 4769651.

(This is part of a dental network offering emergency appointments across Cheshire and Merseyside. It has a Manchester number but is charged at local rate. It is usually easier to get through on the telephone in the mornings.)

They have been recent changes in how emergency dental treatment is offered. The service no longer sits with just one practice but is spread across a number of practices, who will provide emergency treatment and any follow-up treatment that is required.

You can contact practices in your area directly, to ask whether they offer emergency dental treatment.

For anyone who is housebound, severely disabled or is unable to access dental treatment, in exceptional circumstances:

• Special Care Dental Service - 01744 731 395 This has very strict criteria and requires a referral from someone such as a medical professional or care worker.
